New Permit/License Information

- 1. **Permit Test**: Document requirements to take the permit test at 1st Drive:
 - DMV Pre-registration Certificate. Go to https://mydmv.colorado.gov/ and select "Apply for a Driver License or ID". (Bring this document to 1st Drive).
 - Photo ID.
 - Home Study attendance log (required for Home Study students).
 - Home Study agreement (required for Home Study students).
- 2. **Permit**: Teen must be at least 15 years old (with driver's education); 16 years old (without driver's education). Bring the following to the DOR with you:
 - DMV Pre-registration Certificate and documents you specified when registering.
 - "Driver Education Course Certificate". (Provided by 1st Drive).
 - "Written Test Certificate" (Provided by 1st Drive if the teen passed the permit test).
 - A parent or legal guardian must accompany the minor.
- 3. <u>License</u>: Teens under 18 must hold their permits for 12 months. Bring the following to the DOR with you:
 - Driving log with 50 hours of recorded driving (required for teens under 18).
 - "6 Hours Driving Behind-the-Wheel Training Certificate" (Provided by 1st Drive via email required for teens between 16 and 16 ½).
 - "Driving Skills Test Certificate" (Provided by 1st Drive after passing the driving test).
 - Proof of current Colorado residency for parents or for teens 18 and older.
 - A parent or legal guardian must accompany the minor.
- 4. Obtain the new permit/license at the Department of Revenue (DOR) located at:
 - 2447 N. Union Blvd, Colorado Springs, CO 80909 (corner of Union and Van Buren).
 - DOR is open Monday through Friday from 7:00am 5:00pm (excluding holidays).
 - You cannot obtain the new permit/license anywhere else in Colorado Springs and the DOR will not process new permits/licenses after 4:00pm.
